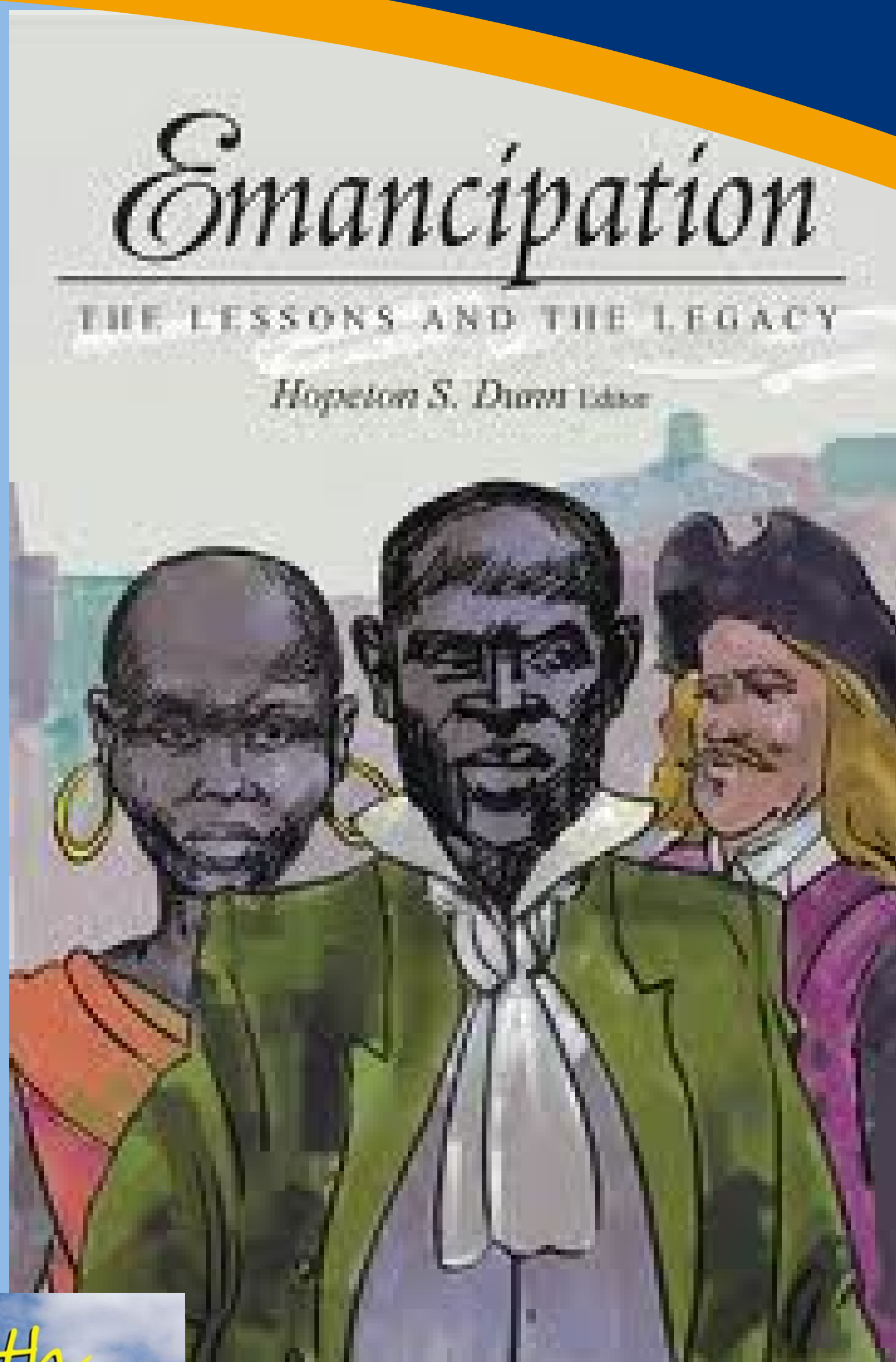




BETHEL BAPTIST CHURCH

Emancipation Lecture Series



In 1994 an idea began in the minds of a few persons to host a lecture series to increase awareness and appreciation of the impact and influence of the experience of Emancipation from slavery. And so, the Emancipation lecture series began under the overarching theme **The Lessons and the Legacy**.

The first lecture was delivered by the late Professor Rex Nettleford. Since then lectures have been delivered annually on or near August 1 which was subsequently designated an official holiday.

The lectures are jointly organized and hosted by the Bethel Baptist Church, Boulevard Baptist Church, Meadowbrook United Church, Webster Memorial United Church, Hope United Church, St. Andrew Scots Kirk United Church and the United Theological College of the West Indies. To date the lecture remains a calendar feature in the ecumenical life of the churches of Jamaica and have explored a variety of themes.

The first 13 lectures have also been compiled and published in a book which now serves as a valuable reference tool for students and researchers.
